

# 2021 Lorain County Fair

## Powder Puff Mini Van Rules

### Acceptable Vans:

- Any FWD/RWD minivans will be allowed. Female drivers only no passengers.

### Preparation:

- Windshield may remain in vehicle or may be removed. If windshield is removed you must use either 9-wire, chain or you may use 2" tubing or flat stock. Must go from roof to dash area. All other glass must be removed.
- You must remove all vehicle trim, door handles, plastic bumper covers, grills, head lamps and tail lamps
- All glass and debris must be cleaned out of van.
- All air bags must be removed or disconnected
- Hood must be opened during inspection.

### Body:

- No Body creasing, Folding or Bending.
- The only door that can be welded all the way around is the driver's door, all other doors and rear hatch can have 2 - 3"x3"x1/4" plate per vertical seam. Or you may 9-wire or chain doors closed in 8 spots per door.
- You may only use the stock bumpers to make and model of van, you may bolt bumpers on with up to 8 bolts or lightly weld to the vehicle. If it is over welded or bolted, you will be asked to cut.
- Hoods may be 9-wired, bolted or chained in 6 spots. Hood will need to have a 12" square hole cut in center in case of a fire.

### Cage:

- You may have a 4-point cage. Drivers door may be reinforced on outside from door seam to door seam. 6" inch tubing maximum.
- You may have a roll over bar.

### Frame/Suspension:

- You are not allowed to reinforce frame in anyway. No pre-bending frame.
- No modification to any of the suspension parts

### Drivetrain:

- No engine Swaps must be engine that came in van.
- No rear end swaps

### Bumpers:

- Any oem bumpers maybe used or you may use DEC or SMW style bumpers

### Tires:

- Skid tires are permitted NO V treads, skids, solid or studded tires permitted.
- No bead locks or plated wheels, you may have valve stem protector.

### Fuel tank & Battery:

- **THIS IS IMPORTANT:** Any fuel system or battery mounting that we feel that is unsafe will not pass. All hoses must be double clamped at all connections. Electric fuel pumps must be operated by a switch and clearly marked so we can shut off in case of a fire. Stock systems will simply use the key.
- Gas tank must be moved to back seat area inside the minivan must be securely fastened and covered. No plastic tanks
- Battery must be moved to inside minivan passenger floorboard. Must be secured fastened and covered.
