 (during the Combine Derby)

- Truck Derby is open to both Lorain County and out of county residents.
- Driver must have a valid Ohio Driver's License at the time of application. No temporary or suspended licenses accepted.
- Any participant under 18 years of age must have a parent/guardian sign a release at the Secretary's Office.

COMPETITION RULES:

- The Lorain County Agricultural Society reserves the right to accept or reject any or all entries.
- All entrants must be in the pit area by 4:00 p.m.
- All drivers must attend the driver's meeting, time and location to be announced.
- Driver MUST wear a crash helmet with eye protection.
- Driver MUST wear a long-sleeved shirt and long pants during his or her heat.
- No hot-rodding in the pit or staging area. Driver will be disqualified.
- NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS OR IN THE PIT AREA. Any driver or crew member found drinking alcohol will be removed from the fairgrounds and the associated truck will be disqualified.
- All decisions by derby officials are final!
- Any truck sitting still during a heat for more than two minutes will be disqualified.
- No driver's door or head-on hits will be allowed – this will be explained at the driver's meeting.
- The Lorain County Agricultural Society and its members will not be held responsible for injuries or damages to cars, entrants, mechanics, or truck owners.
